FALL PROGRAM RECAP AND LOOKING TO THE WINTER

Autumn is the best season. Partially because of the beautiful colors, the falling leaves, and the fact that we can all finally pull out our favorite jackets and scarves. These things are great, but the real highlight of the fall season is Podium RVA's program session. It sets the tone for the school year, and, needless to say, we are off to a great start! We hosted five high school programs, six middle school programs, and one pop-up program with Petersburg community partners Hebron VA and Communities in Schools (CIS) at Vernon Johns Middle School. We started with a new 21st Century site in Henrico, John Rolfe Middle School, and worked with the Metro Richmond Boys and Girls Club to pilot weekly programming at the Northside Boys and Girls Club. We are so proud to have worked with 285 youth this fall, and we are so excited for all that's to come in the new year!

Currently, our plans for the winter are to continue hosting programs in all four of our service regions: Richmond, Henrico, Petersburg, and Hopewell. On top of all middle and high school programs continuing with us through the winter session, Podium will also be working with Higher Achievement to support their Love Out Loud Richmond poets, hosting another pop-up with Hebron VA at Blandford Academy in Petersburg, and piloting workshops with CIS of Petersburg to mentor youth in their Girls With Pearls and Guys With Ties leadership programs. We are all bundled up and excited to continue serving as consistent and reliable youth mentors across Greater Richmond and the Tri-Cities this winter!
