Most of all, I love the opportunity to serve Richmond and Tri-Cities youth in the new year! This winter session, we hosted six high school programs and eight middle school programs. A few highlights: We worked with the Southside Boys and Girls Club to provide our Weekly Word program, where our youth produced their very own newspaper publication. We also worked with Higher Achievement to prepare youth at Boushall, Dogwood, and Henderson middle schools for their annual Love Out Loud Poetry Competition. It was incredible to watch young people express themselves through poetry at such a pivotal moment in their development, and we are so proud of all our youth this session!

We will continue to nurture our year-long commitments to youth in Richmond, Henrico, Petersburg, and Hopewell during our upcoming spring program session. Our partnerships with The Well in Hopewell and with 21st Community Learning Centers in Richmond and Henrico are still going strong! New for this session, we're partnering with CIS of Petersburg to host two youth pop-ups focused on providing social emotional learning, self-advocacy, and writing as a tool for healing. We are excited to continue to serve as reliable mentors to young people across Greater Richmond and the Tri-Cities; let's finish out this school year strong!

#### PODIUM GIVES BACK



Not only does Podium focus on youth literacy and professional development, it also works to support children holistically in their growth and education. To do this, Podium gives back to many partners in many different ways. Here are a couple of highlights from this winter:

#### **#1. Podium and the Mary & Francis Youth Center at VCU**

In January, Podium hosted a parent engagement night at the <u>Mary & Francis Youth Center</u>. Focusing on using writing as a tool to reduce stress and to relax, Podium mentors worked with parents to "Breathe Easy!" Thanks to the Target on Laburnum, Podium was also able to donate 25 glue bottles for a February slime night at the Mary & Francis Youth Center!





#### #2. Podium and ReEstablish Richmond

In February, Podium connected with <u>ReEstablish</u> <u>Richmond</u>, a local nonprofit working to connect refugees and newer immigrants to resources needed to establish roots, build community, and become self-sufficient. Starting up their winter family literacy classes, Podium saw a call for supplies and jumped at the opportunity to support! Thanks to the Target on Laburnum, Podium provided glue, erasures, binders, pencils, and dry erase markers to support ReEstablish Richmond's current family literacy cohort!




# WELCOME BOARD & YOUNG PROFESSIONAL BOARD LEADERSHIP

#### FLASH FICTION COMPETITION - LEAP YEAR EDITION


