
Self-Harm Awareness Beverlin P.S. Fairfield MS

Quickly


Ran to her to

Used their claws to travel through


Vents for help.

Use their little legs to run


Very fast!

Zariah.






Story Building & Scripts

Jasira: No, but we should follow them, so we don't get lost.


Jonathan and Maleah start running away.
